The Mount Rainier Radio Control Society was formed in 1964 and began flying at the Bethel School. In 1975 the club moved to 1516 Harts Lake Loop Road, which is the current flying location. The club owns the 85 acre site which boasts a 300 feet by 40 feet asphalt runway, an enclosed shelter, sanitary facilities, and ample space for tent camping or recreational vehicles. Electricity, water, and telephone are on site.

Membership is open to persons interested in radio controlled aircraft. Dues are \$125 a year for persons over age 17 and are prorated for new members. Dues are \$50.00 for younger members. All flying members must be members of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA). Members of other AMA clubs are welcome to fly at the field as guests, but must be AMA members.
